

NOTES FOR COMPLETION OF MEMBERSHIP FORM 2012

- ◆ All members will pay £20, and in addition, each household (1 or 2 adults) will pay £20 for water activities. Additional adults will pay a further £20 each. Juniors and Students will not pay a water activity fee.
- ◆ Water activities – any member who takes to the water in any craft.

Includes any member who helms or acts as regular crew of dinghies but not 'guest' crew who sail no more than 4x per season (equivalent to other guests under Rule 5b). Includes any member who helms or acts as regular crew on cruisers but not guests who sail no more than 4x per season (nor would such guests be expected to join the club). Includes any members who kayak or row & who use the club facilities (any SSC equipment, boat store or clubhouse, showers, changing rooms).

Excludes safety boat crew who do not go on the water in their own right.

- ◆ Please complete the whole of the form even if you are just renewing your membership, as we need to keep the records updated to assist us in the day to day running of the Club. Once complete then please return to the Membership Secretary at Saundersfoot Sailing Club, The Harbour, Saundersfoot, Pembrokeshire, SA69 9HE.
- ◆ Annual membership expires on December 31st of each year and fees are due at that time for the following year. For those members joining after September 30th then the initial membership will run until December 31st in the following year.
- ◆ Membership is open to all persons over the age of 18 on January 1st in the current year.
Junior Membership is open to children aged 5 to 18.
Student Membership is open to those aged 18 to 25 who are in full time education.
Reduced Membership of £15 is open only to members over 65 who do not use the Clubs sailing facilities.
For clarification of these categories see current Club Rules which are displayed in the Clubhouse.
- ◆ Only adult and student members are entitled to a vote at a General Meeting of the Club.
- ◆ It is important that we have the correct details of your boats, particularly if you require a space in the dinghy or tender park. These spaces are currently in great demand and priority will be given to those members who actively use their boats throughout the season and only one space will be allocated to each active dinghy helm. Spaces will be allocated on an annual basis prior to the start of each racing season and members should keep to their allocated space. Should you need a space for a short period only, during the summer, then please let us know when that is and we will try and accommodate you. We regret that we are no longer able to make spaces available for those boats that are not actively used throughout the season; the space available to us is too valuable to be used as cheap and convenient long term boat storage.
- ◆ The SHC Slipway Fee is payable by dinghy and kayak sailors who rent spaces in the Club dinghy park. It represents the dues levied by the Harbour Commission for the use of its facilities and is collected on their behalf by the Club.
- ◆ Each application for New Membership must be supported by a Proposer and Secunder, each of whom must be adult Members of the Club. Applications submitted without these signatures or the appropriate fee will not be accepted. Each application for new membership must be approved by the General Committee, which may refuse to admit the application without stating any reason. If membership is refused or a dinghy park space withheld then the appropriate fee will be refunded.
- ◆ The Club is operated entirely on a voluntary basis and all members benefit from the facilities provided. Members are expected to play a full part in the running of the club, please indicate where you can offer assistance in various ways. If you require some training or would like to undertake a duty in an assisting capacity then this can be arranged.
- ◆ A copy of the Club Rules and list of members is available for inspection in the Clubhouse.
